



Toilet Training Information

At Episcopal Day School, the policy is that all enrolled Early Childhood students are to be toilet trained as we are a preschool, not a daycare facility. Toilet training is teaching your child to recognize their body signals for urinating and having a bowel movement. It also means teaching your child to use a potty chair or toilet correctly and at the appropriate times.

A Toilet Trained Child can:

1. Tell an adult they have to go to the restroom BEFORE they have to go.
2. Pull down and back up again, underwear and pants without assistance (including buttons, snaps, and zippers).
3. Wipe themselves after using the bathroom.
4. Get off the toilet without assistance.
5. Wash and dry hands independently.
6. Postpone going if they must wait for someone who is in the bathroom OR if outside away from the bathroom, until an adult can walk them inside.
